STRATEGIC CONTEXT AND PURPOSE

This meeting marked the formal initiation of a strategic partnership between Anveshane and APD, a pivotal stakeholder in disability rights across Karnataka. The purpose was to define a joint execution strategy for the '**Yes to Access**' project, aimed at systematically addressing the critical lack of accessible infrastructure in public and private spaces throughout the state.

The collaboration directly supports Anveshane's commitment to strengthening psycho-socio-economic development by eliminating physical barriers, thereby promoting dignity and participation for marginalized communities.

2. KEY DISCUSSION SUMMARY

Shri Srinivas from APD provided a comprehensive overview of the 'Yes to Access' initiative, emphasizing its dual approach: awareness/advocacy and data-driven mapping.

- **Promoting 'Yes to Access' App:** The app serves as the central data repository, allowing users to crowd-source and record accessibility data (audits) of various locations. The partnership focuses on utilizing Anveshane's grassroots network to significantly increase the data density within the app across diverse regions in Karnataka.
- **Education and Awareness:** Discussion centered on utilizing Anveshane's strong community presence (as outlined in the NGO Action Plan) to conduct awareness sessions. These sessions will focus on educating the general public and stakeholders about the critical idea of accessible spaces and the proper use of the auditing app.
- **Accessibility Audit Drives:** The core implementation strategy involves mobilizing Anveshane's team members and future volunteers to conduct structured accessibility audits (e.g., assessing ramps, restrooms, entrances, signage) in high-traffic public areas, schools, and government buildings across various districts. This activity is essential for validating the organizational goal of completing up to **1,000 audits annually**.

3. DECISIONS AND KEY OUTCOMES

The meeting successfully established clear responsibilities and foundational operational agreements for the collaborative effort:

Key Outcome / Decision	Responsibility
Formalization of Partnership	Anveshane and APD Leadership (To document shared objectives and scope of work).
Team Training	Anveshane Team (Mahendra, Sushmitha, Umar) to undergo necessary training by APD on the Yes to Access audit methodology and app utilization.
Pilot Audit Planning	Anveshane team to select and map a pilot district/municipality for the initial set of structured audits.
Volunteer Operational Support	APD committed to covering Travel and Food Expenses for volunteers engaged in the Accessibility Audit Drives, contingent upon increased volunteer mobilization for scale.
Resource Mobilization	Integrate audit drives into Anveshane's execution schedule (Approx. 5 days per month, aligned with NGO Action Plan).

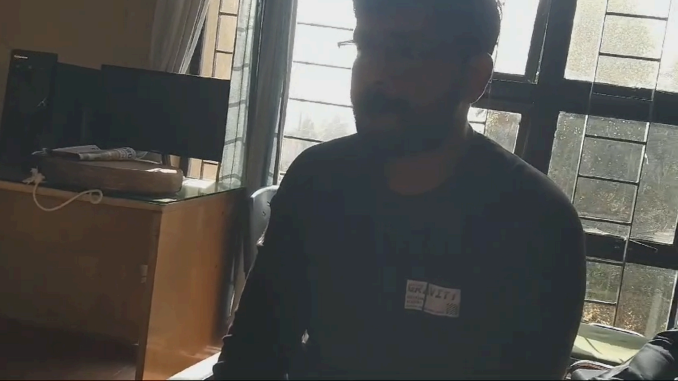
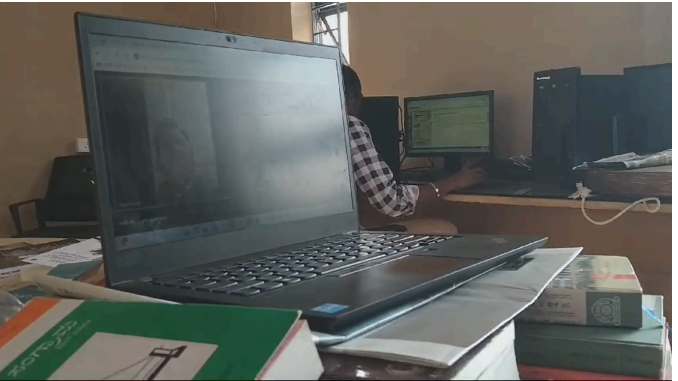
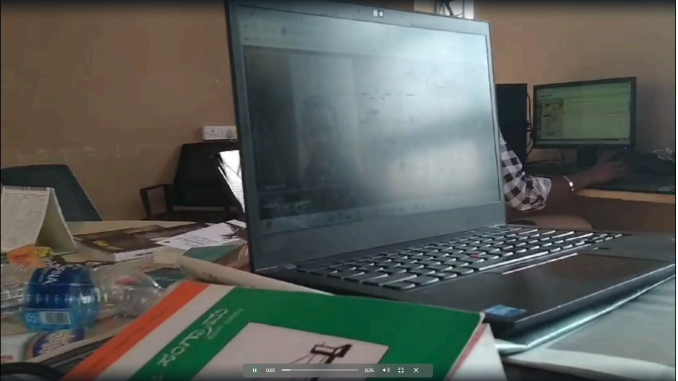

The success of the 'Yes to Access' collaboration hinges on sustained community engagement and efficient volunteer mobilization. The operational support provided by APD, covering travel and food expenses for volunteers, creates a critical incentive for scaling our audit drives effectively. Anveshane's leadership is now tasked with translating this strategic partnership into on-the-ground action, ensuring robust training, maximizing volunteer participation, and meticulously documenting audit data to drive actionable, state-level advocacy for mandatory accessible standards.

1. STRATEGIC CONTEXT AND PURPOSE

This high-level consultation was convened by a joint platform of student and social organizations to strategically push for the implementation of the **'Rohit Act' at the Karnataka state level**. The Act is intended to serve as a comprehensive, legally binding framework to explicitly address and prevent the systemic caste discrimination, harassment, and institutional violence faced by Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribe (ST) students within educational institutions and universities.

Anveshane's participation underscores our commitment to dismantling institutional barriers, a prerequisite for achieving genuine **Psycho-Socio-Economic Development** and fostering mental well-being in vulnerable communities. The consultation focused on preventing institutionalized mechanisms that lead Dalit and Adivasi students to distress and suicide, referencing the 2016 institutional murder of research scholar Rohith Vemula at Hyderabad Central University (HCU).

2. KEY PROCEEDINGS AND DISCUSSIONS

The meeting successfully brought together youth representatives from various universities across Karnataka, providing a platform for testimonies and strategic planning.

- **Emotional & Moral Imperative:** The presence of **Smt. Radhika Vemula**, mother of Rohith Vemula, added a profound and urgent moral dimension to the discussion, centering the consultation on the personal tragedy caused by institutional bias.

- **Leadership & Direction:** The session was presided over by **Shri. Mavalli Shankar**, a senior leader of the Dalit movement, who stressed the necessity of the 'Rohit Act' as an essential shield against caste practices and discrimination that often go unaddressed by the existing SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act within educational campuses.
- **Systemic Failure:** Discussions highlighted the consistent pattern of harassment, discrimination, and neglect across educational bodies, demonstrating that the need for the Act is urgent and state-wide. The consensus was that without specific legislation targeting campus spaces, these systemic issues would continue to push students toward extreme steps.
- **Mobilization and Data:** Emphasis was placed on uniting student forces from different universities (like ASA, BAPSA, etc.) and preparing to mobilize a strong advocacy push.

3. ORGANIZATIONAL OUTCOMES AND NEXT STEPS

The key takeaway for Anveshane is the formal integration into the ongoing Rohit Act Janaandolana platform.

Key Outcome / Decision	Responsibility / Mandate for Anveshane
Advocacy Commitment	Anveshane officially commits to supporting the 'Rohit Act' advocacy effort across its network and utilizing its NGO status to lobby key governmental and educational stakeholders.
Youth Mobilization	Leverage Anveshane's network of college volunteers (as per the NGO Action Plan) to identify and register more student representatives (SC/ST cell heads, progressive student bodies) for future, larger events.
Documentation Support	Utilize organizational capacity to assist the joint forum in preparing formal documentation and policy briefs required for effective advocacy with the state legislature.
Logistics Support	Supported the event logistics, specifically managing the registration process (via Google Form) to accurately account for food and seating arrangements for delegates.

4. CONCLUSION AND FORWARD OUTLOOK

The Consultation Meeting was a critical success in consolidating the collective will of various organizations toward achieving the 'Rohit Act' in Karnataka. For Anveshane, this event is a powerful demonstration of our commitment to **Inclusivity**, linking our mental health mandate directly to the fight for social justice. Our next

immediate steps are to ensure the momentum is maintained through active volunteer recruitment from campuses and by contributing logistical and documentation support to the joint movement. This advocacy work is indispensable to creating equitable, dignified, and mentally safe educational environments.

1. STRATEGIC CONTEXT AND PURPOSE

This online orientation meeting served as a crucial step in Anveshane's strategy to scale its operations and impact by strengthening its volunteer base and ensuring organizational transparency. The primary purpose was to formally introduce the organization's mission, vision, and core values to potential new volunteers and stakeholders.

The meeting was designed to clarify:

- Organizational Identity:** The legal standing (Registered on Jan 16, 2024) and the constitutional values adhered to by Anveshane.
- Strategic Focus:** Reinforcing the primary commitment to **Youth Mental Health** while detailing the broader seven core project areas (Poshane, Olume, Bembala, etc.).
- Mobilization:** Converting interested individuals into active participants, a key objective for sustained community engagement across Karnataka.

2. KEY PROCEEDINGS AND DISCUSSIONS (AGENDA SUMMARY)

The session followed the planned agenda, effectively communicating Anveshane’s holistic approach to community transformation.

What is our NGO about?	Core Values & Mission: Detailed the commitment to Humanitarianism, Inclusivity, Environmental Sustainability, and Constitutional Values. Emphasized the goal of strengthening psycho-socio-economic development across all communities, with a current priority focus on Youth Mental Health .
What have we been doing?	Past Work & Achievements: Shared highlights from the previous year, including NGO registration, initial community activities (e.g., school painting drives, Constitution Day celebration), and the establishment of initial external collaborations.
What are our future plans?	Key Initiatives: Outlined the seven main projects: <i>Poshane</i> (Hunger), <i>Olume</i> (Children's Welfare), <i>Bembala</i> (Women's Empowerment), <i>Aadara</i> (Marginalized Support), <i>Hodiike</i> (Shelter-less), <i>Sahabalve</i> (LGBTQIA+/Transgender Support), and <i>Samathe</i> (Dalit/Adivasi Welfare). Future plans included NIMHANS training, health camps, and establishing a Toastmasters Club.

Call to Action: Clear pathways for involvement were presented: Volunteer service, network expansion, spreading awareness via social media, and financial donations. The call stressed that professional skills and time are equally valued in service to the cause.

3. ORGANIZATIONAL OUTCOMES AND NEXT STEPS

The meeting concluded with a highly positive response, resulting in a solidified recruitment funnel for the organization.

Volunteer Intake	30 Participants showed active interest. The immediate next step is to follow up with all attendees to onboard them and assign them to specific project leads (e.g., Mental Health, Accessibility, Education).
Clarified Focus	The seven core projects and the key focus on Youth Mental Health were successfully communicated, ensuring new members understand the breadth and depth of Anveshane's mandate.
Documentation & Transparency	Meeting minutes were recorded and circulated (as verified by uploaded documents), fulfilling the internal mandate for accurate and regular NGO documentation.
Increased Reach	The online platform facilitated participation across different geographic regions, expanding Anveshane's potential volunteer database beyond Bengaluru.

4. CONCLUSION AND FORWARD OUTLOOK

This orientation meeting successfully translated Anveshane's strategic vision into actionable commitment from new individuals. The turnout and engagement demonstrated a strong public appetite for the organization's holistic focus, particularly in mental health and inclusivity. Our immediate outlook is to integrate these **30 new prospects** into active roles to support the upcoming high-priority events, such as the Rohit Act advocacy and the APD Accessibility Audits, thereby ensuring the organization maintains momentum and sustainability.

1. STRATEGIC CONTEXT AND PURPOSE

Anveshane's participation in and promotion of the "Citizen Contribution to Shieldtail Conservation" webinar served the dual purpose of fulfilling our environmental mandate and enhancing the scientific literacy of our volunteer network. This collaboration with the Aghanaashini Nature Foundation is a proactive step in realizing our commitment to **Environmental Sustainability** and **Climate Change Awareness**—a stated focus area in our mission.

The primary objectives for Anveshane's involvement were:

1. **Capacity Building:** To expose volunteers to high-quality, scientific knowledge on endemic species and biodiversity within the Western Ghats region of Karnataka.
2. **Networking:** To formalize and strengthen the relationship with a dedicated environmental organization (Aghanaashini Nature Foundation) for potential future joint fieldwork and awareness campaigns.
3. **Advocacy Preparation:** To understand the role of 'Citizen Science' in data collection, a model that could potentially be adapted for our own accessibility and social audit drives.

2. KEY PROCEEDINGS AND KNOWLEDGE TRANSFER

Dr. Vivek Philip Cyriac delivered an insightful session on Shieldtails (endemic, non-venomous snakes primarily found in the Western Ghats), focusing on their ecological significance and conservation challenges.

- **Shieldtail Ecology:** The discussion emphasized the Shieldtails' role as a key indicator species for forest health and soil ecology, highlighting the threat posed by habitat destruction and climate change.
- **Citizen Science Model:** A significant portion of the webinar focused on how ordinary citizens can contribute verifiable data for conservation efforts. This included methods for non-invasive species identification, geographical plotting, and the ethical conduct required while observing wildlife.
- **Conservation Imperative:** The talk reinforced the urgency of localized conservation efforts. Given Anveshane's strong presence across Karnataka, this knowledge is highly relevant for integrating environmental sensitivity into our community outreach programs.
- **Registration Management:** Anveshane assisted the host in promoting the mandatory Google Form registration, ensuring wide dissemination across our volunteer and student networks.

3. ORGANIZATIONAL OUTCOMES AND NEXT STEPS

The collaboration successfully expanded Anveshane's knowledge base and external network, providing immediate and long-term strategic value.

Knowledge Integration	The core team will develop a brief on 'Environmental Sensitivity' to be included in all future volunteer training and community clean-up drives.
Network Expansion	A formal follow-up is mandated with the Aghanaashini Nature Foundation to discuss potential joint activities related to tree plantation and environmental awareness workshops in rural colleges.
Adaptation of Citizen Model	The methodology of collecting high-quality field data via citizen contribution (as discussed for Shieldtails) will be reviewed for potential application in the APD Accessibility Audits to enhance data accuracy and volunteer engagement.
Targeted Outreach	The webinar served as a specialized awareness event, effectively engaging the segment of our volunteer base interested specifically in ecology and environment.

4. CONCLUSION AND FORWARD OUTLOOK

This partnership with the Aghanaashini Nature Foundation was a vital success in upholding Anveshane's commitment to sustainable transformation. The knowledge gained regarding biodiversity and citizen science will be immediately leveraged to enrich our training modules and field activities, moving beyond simple clean-up drives towards **data-driven environmental action**. 1. STRATEGIC CONTEXT AND PURPOSE

This event, held in strong collaboration with **Drusti Charitable Trust** and the Samarpana Team, was a powerful one-day celebration aligned with the birth anniversary of **Louis Braille**. Anveshane's commitment to **Inclusivity** was demonstrated by deploying dedicated volunteers to manage the comprehensive program, which focused on the cultural expression, intellectual engagement, and essential health needs of the visually impaired community in Mysuru.

The strategic objectives for Anveshane's involvement were:

1. **Affirmation of Dignity:** To create a safe, supportive, and empowering environment for visually impaired individuals to showcase their talents in cultural and intellectual pursuits.
2. **Operational Excellence:** To provide highly organized logistical and one-on-one participant support, allowing the collaborating organizations to maximize the event's social and health impact.
3. **Capacity Building:** To give Anveshane volunteers practical experience in facilitating complex cultural and health events for People with Disabilities (PWD), directly feeding into the **APD Accessibility Audits** project.

2. KEY PROCEEDINGS AND ANVESHANE'S CONTRIBUTION

The one-day cultural celebration successfully blended artistic expression, essential health services, and intellectual activities at the Bhudanukunte Kalyana Mantapa. Anveshane volunteers, working alongside the Samarpana team, formed the core operational unit responsible for participant support.

A. Volunteer Management and Logistical Support

Anveshane deployed a dedicated team of volunteers who primarily focused on:

- **Venue Management:** Directing participants, managing crowds, and coordinating the timely transitions between cultural stages, health camps, and meal areas.
- **Individual Facilitation:** Providing personal guidance and support to blind participants across the venue, from registration to activity areas, ensuring their security and comfort throughout the day.
- **Resource Coordination:** Managing the logistical flow of refreshments, rest area access, and coordinating with the administrative teams of **Drusti Charitable Trust** and Samarpana.

B. Activity Support (Cultural, Intellectual, and Health)

1. STRATEGIC CONTEXT AND PURPOSE

This collaborative event with the Global Humanity Development Trust was strategically timed on Republic Day to maximize the symbolic significance of the nation's founding document. Anveshane's participation was driven by its core value of adhering to **Constitutional Values** and supporting **Education** among vulnerable communities.

The strategic objectives for Anveshane's involvement were:

1. **Educational Equity:** To provide essential books and stationery to school children, directly alleviating financial burdens and promoting continuous learning.

This collaborative webinar was strategically essential for bridging the knowledge gap regarding the legal rights and protections available to women against domestic abuse and workplace harassment (POSH - Prevention of Sexual Harassment). Anveshane, along with Muktha Foundation, Young Indians Bengaluru, and Nyaaya, organized this free session as a core component of its **Psycho-socio-economic development** mandate.

The strategic objectives for Anveshane's involvement were:

1. **Legal Literacy:** To empower attendees with clear, accessible knowledge of relevant laws and redressal mechanisms.
2. **Harm Reduction:** To provide information that can prevent or mitigate psychological distress arising from violence and harassment.
3. **Capacity Building:** To train Anveshane volunteers in foundational legal concepts related to gender-based violence, improving their ability to counsel and refer community members effectively.

- **Domestic Violence (DV) Law:** Detailed explanation of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, including definitions of violence (physical, emotional, economic), protection orders, and the role of Protection Officers.
- **Workplace Sexual Harassment Law:** Comprehensive review of the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 (POSH Act), focusing on the internal complaints mechanism (ICC), the definition of a 'workplace,' and the steps for filing a formal complaint.
- **Redressal Mechanisms:** Clear guidance on how to access legal aid, engage police services, and utilize the formal and informal procedures available under both acts.

1. STRATEGIC CONTEXT AND PURPOSE

This three-day intensive painting drive aligns perfectly with Anveshane's core mission to drive **sustainable community transformation** via a **volunteer-driven, minimal-to-zero organizational expenditure approach**. The School Painting Initiative is a key project under the **Education** mandate, aimed at creating a vibrant, welcoming environment that encourages student attendance and fosters a positive psychological connection to learning.

The strategic objectives for this joint effort with the Samarpana Team, executed under a **Zero/Minimal Expenditure Model**, were:

1. **Infrastructure Upliftment:** To provide a fresh, motivational aesthetic makeover to a rural government school by utilizing **mobilized in-kind resources and volunteer-borne contributions**.
2. **Mental Health Support (Indirect):** To use color and imagery to create a joyful learning space, recognizing that the physical environment is a silent factor in the mental well-being of students and teachers.
3. **Volunteer Fulfillment:** To provide a high-impact, tangible activity that promotes **joy, creativity, and fulfilment** among volunteers, strengthening the self-sustaining nature of the base.

2. KEY PROCEEDINGS AND PROJECT EXECUTION

The three-day project was executed meticulously, converting a run-down structure into a bright, educational space through focused volunteer efforts and resourcefulness.

A. Preparatory and Execution Phases

The project was led by the Samarpana Team, with significant manpower and coordination support provided by Anveshane volunteers.

- **Prep Work (Day 1):** Volunteers engaged in surface cleaning, scraping, and preparing the exterior and interior walls of the school building.

The strategic objectives for Anveshane's involvement were:

2. **Community Mobilization:** To execute a highly effective **community registration and outreach campaign**, ensuring eligible participants (9–26 years, all genders) were mobilized and attended the free drive, consistent with our self-reliant, resource-mobilization model.
3. **Preventive Advocacy:** To utilize the platform to educate the public on the necessity of the HPV vaccine for **all genders**, promoting a comprehensive approach to cancer prevention.

2. KEY PROCEEDINGS AND EXECUTION

The event was characterized by high organization, distinguished presence, and efficient beneficiary flow.

A. Dignitary Inauguration and High Visibility

The collaborative service drive yielded profound public health and organizational benefits:

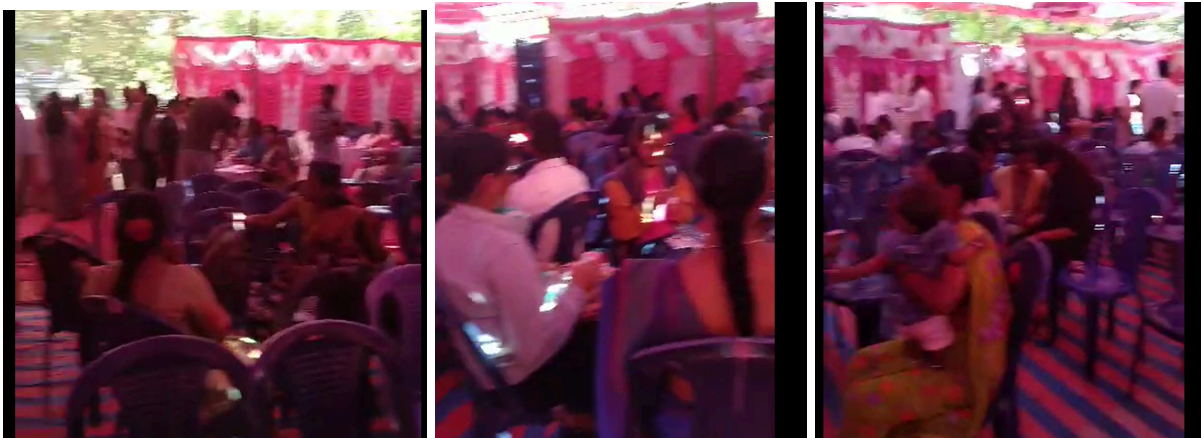

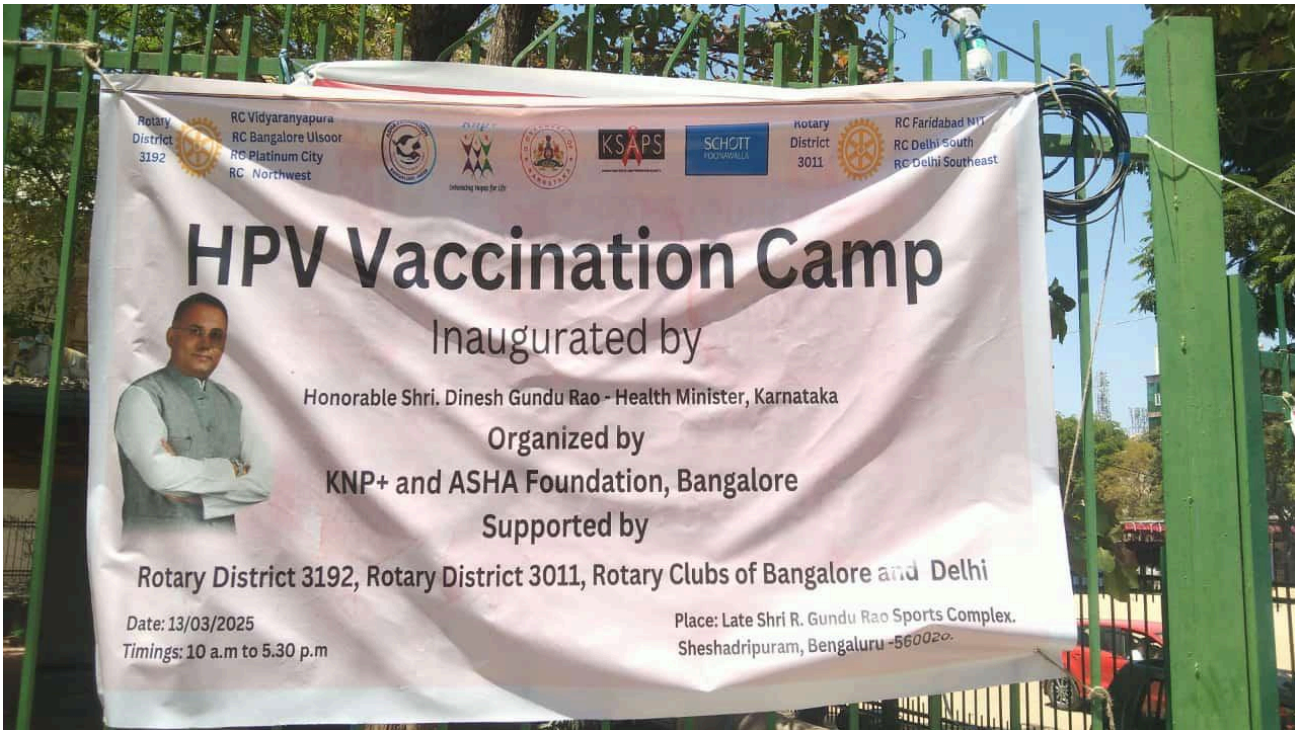

The focus on Atyids (freshwater shrimps) provided detailed insights into local biodiversity and ecological health indicators.

The resource person, **Mr. Maclean Antony Santos** (Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Young Research Fellow), is a field expert who recently discovered a new shrimp species. This collaboration provided access to cutting-edge, localized scientific research.

1. **Scientific Capacity Building:** To acquire expert knowledge on the identification, distribution, and conservation challenges of Atyids, enabling informed future environmental advocacy.

1. STRATEGIC CONTEXT AND PURPOSE

The observance of **World Forest Day** (March 21st) was conducted as a dual-pronged strategy: **Internal Knowledge Consolidation** and **External Public Advocacy**. This initiative aligns directly with Anveshane's **Environmental Sustainability** mandate, emphasizing education and awareness as the primary tools for conservation.

The core objectives of this awareness drive were:

- Volunteer Education:** To hold a focused internal huddle to ensure all participating volunteers were aligned on the complex ecological, economic, and social functions of forests (as defined by the FAO and other scientific bodies).
- Zero-Expenditure Advocacy:** To leverage the research and discussion to create highly detailed, accurate informational material, which was then disseminated widely across digital platforms (WhatsApp) to maximize public knowledge without any financial outlay.

2. KEY PROCEEDINGS AND KNOWLEDGE DISSEMINATION

The initiative was executed efficiently within the framework of Anveshane's self-sustaining model:

A. Internal Huddle and Research (30 Minutes)

- A 30-minute internal huddle was conducted to discuss and synthesize the comprehensive content regarding the definition of forests, the four natural factors influencing their growth (Topography, Soil, Climate, Moisture), and the seven critical benefits of forests (timber/fuel, wildlife habitat, soil conservation, flood control, impact on climate, groundwater recharge, and fuel origin).
- The huddle ensured the volunteers were equipped with a **scientific and well-rounded perspective** before engaging in public communication.

B. Public Dissemination

- Following the huddle, the synthesized, detailed content (in Kannada and English) was immediately shared across all **WhatsApp groups** and other digital channels.
- This act served as a powerful piece of **zero-cost public service advocacy**, educating the community on the scientific complexity and necessity of forest conservation under the call to action: "#ಕಾಡು ಬೆಳೆಸಿ ನಾಡು ಉಳಿಸಿ" (Grow Forests, Save the Land).

1. STRATEGIC CONTEXT AND PURPOSE

This two-day specialized workshop represents a significant step forward in Anveshane's strategy to address community psychological needs proactively. While the earlier Jan 2024 workshop focused on therapy models, this training targets a universal source of stress and conflict: **interpersonal relationships (Maduve, Preethi, Sambandhagala Nirvahane)**.

The primary purpose was to equip team members with practical **counseling skills** to provide early, informal support for community members facing relationship challenges. - **Knowledge Transfer:** The focus on practical skills enables attendees to bring this expertise back to the organization, further enriching Anveshane's internal knowledge base and zero-cost training model.
- **Networking:** Attending this event strengthens Anveshane's ties with professional psychologists, providing crucial access to mental health experts for future collaboration (like the subsequent "ಹಗುರಾಗಲೀ ಮನಸ್ಸು" webinars).

World TB Day provides a vital opportunity to educate our volunteer network and the wider community about Tuberculosis (TB) facts, symptoms, and the importance of early intervention.

The activity was executed entirely under the **Self-Sustaining, Zero-Expenditure Model** by leveraging the volunteer network for learning and outreach:

1. To ensure volunteers have an accurate understanding of TB, combating misinformation.
2. To utilize the existing volunteer communication channels (WhatsApp groups) for wide-reaching, immediate information dissemination.

The event consisted of a highly focused internal huddle followed by a structured dissemination strategy:

- **Internal Huddle:** A dedicated **30-minute session** was conducted by a core volunteer to discuss essential facts about TB, including transmission, testing, treatment, and the global efforts to eliminate the disease.
- **Knowledge Consolidation:** The scientific information, based on the huddle discussion, was synthesized into concise, impactful messaging (including key images and quotes).
- **Public Dissemination:** This finalized information package was strategically **shared across all Anveshane-managed WhatsApp groups** and volunteer social channels, ensuring rapid and accurate public health messaging on the critical day.

- **Data Submission:** All collected data, including photographic evidence and detailed observations, was uploaded directly via the app to APD, contributing to a large, usable database for urban planning and advocacy.

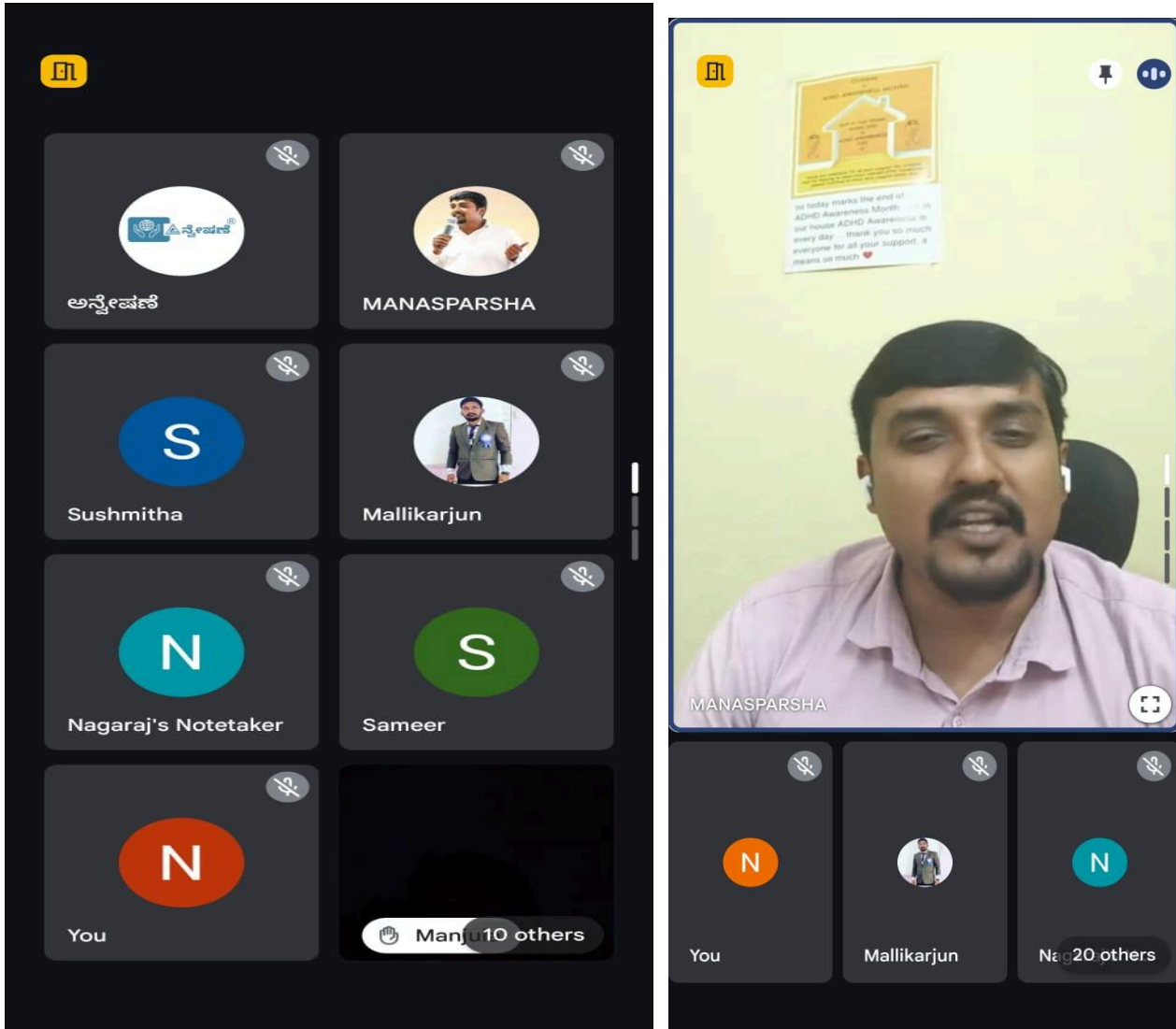

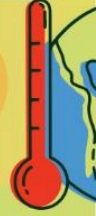

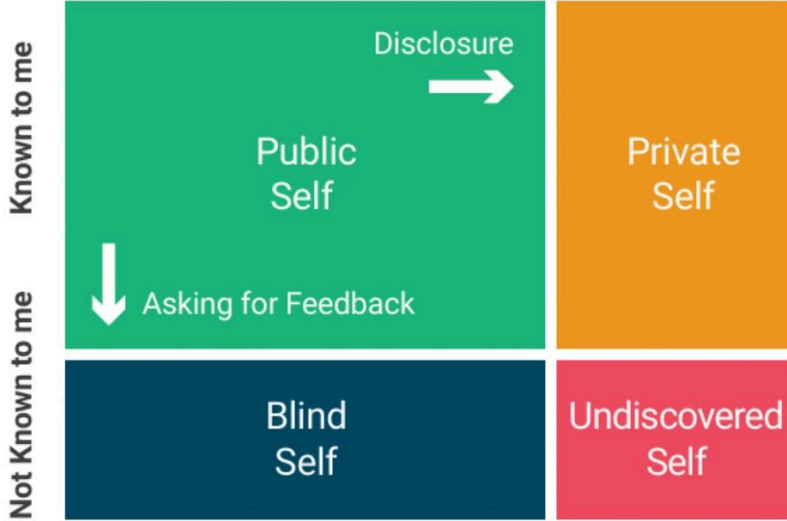

This consultation meeting was a critical step in the ongoing effort to prevent the felling of 368 trees in the Bengaluru Cantonment Railway Colony. The meeting, organized by the BBMP, allowed the Railway Land Development Authority (RLDA) to present its case and, crucially, for the public (including Anveshane and partner collectives like PaNaSa) to voice objections and propose alternatives following the submission of objection emails and petitions.

Anveshane's role was:

1. **Show Solidarity:** Maintain visible support for the collaborative effort to conserve the trees.
2. **Witness and Document:** Observe and document the proceedings to inform future advocacy efforts.
3. **Collaborative Support:** Stand with the wider activist community, lending weight to their collective objection.

2. KEY PROCEEDINGS AND EXECUTION

The event was a significant advocacy exercise involving both physical and virtual attendance, demonstrating the breadth of public concern:

- **High-Level Engagement:** The meeting involved senior officials from regulatory bodies (BBMP) and the proposing authority (RLDA), making Anveshane's presence vital.
- **Public Objection Delivery:** The gathered solidarity reinforced the depth of public opposition to the project, stemming from the objections previously mobilized by Anveshane and its partners.
- **Hybrid Access:** The provision of both physical attendance and an online Webex option (with detailed logistical guidance) ensured maximum possible participation, which Anveshane leveraged through its representative.

GREENS SEE RED

Citizens rally against felling of 368 trees in Cantonment Railway Colony

BENGALURU, DHNS

On Thursday, over 50 people gathered at Gandhi Bhavan to protest the proposed felling of 368 trees at the Cantonment Railway Colony in Vasanth Nagar. The tree felling has been proposed to facilitate a commercial railway development project.

The Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike (BBMP) issued a public notice regarding the plan on April 25.

As the trees cover a significant portion of the Cantonment premises, the move has raised concerns among local residents and environmentalists, who fear it will further deplete Bengaluru's already dwindling green cover.

After the demonstration at Gandhi Bhavan, the crowd visited the railway colony, symbolically hugged the trees, and raised slogans like 'Save Trees, Save Bengaluru.' Multiple citizen groups and environmental organisations, including

Vruksha Foundation and Parisarakagi Navu, participated.

Environmental activist Alexander James, in his 60s, recalled planting about 20 trees in the colony as a child. "This was about 20-25 years ago. Back then, there was

Miller's Tank here, and the spot was beautiful. Today, the colony is home to over 60 heritage trees," he said.

A public consultation on the matter is scheduled for Tuesday, involving citizens, the Forest Department, and railway officials. Residents hope the meeting, convened by Forest Minister Eshwar Khandre, will not be "a mere eyewash".

"Several such consultations have happened, but little has changed. We hope the authorities reconsider the project after seeing how important these trees are — not just for cleaner air and lowering temperatures, but also for recharging the water table," said Vinod Jacob, General Manager, Namma Bengaluru Foundation.

- **Youth-Centric Design:** The workshop was specifically designed for the youth community, ensuring the relevance of the content to Anveshane’s target demographic.
- **Resource Investment:** By sending Mahendra to attend, Anveshane invested key volunteer time and effort to secure invaluable knowledge, which is the primary resource under the **Self-Sustaining Model**.

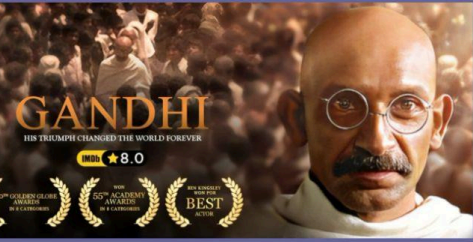

- **Zero-Cost Mobilization:** Anveshane primarily contributed through **outreach and volunteer presence**, utilizing established WhatsApp groups and partner networks (Self-Sustaining Model).
- **Targeted Location:** The action was held directly at the site of controversy (Cantonment Railway Colony), ensuring maximum visual impact.
- **Unified Messaging:** The collaborative nature of the event, bringing multiple groups together under the banner of tree protection, amplified the message against the proposed development lease to Bagmane Developers.

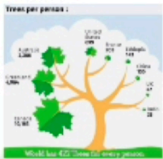
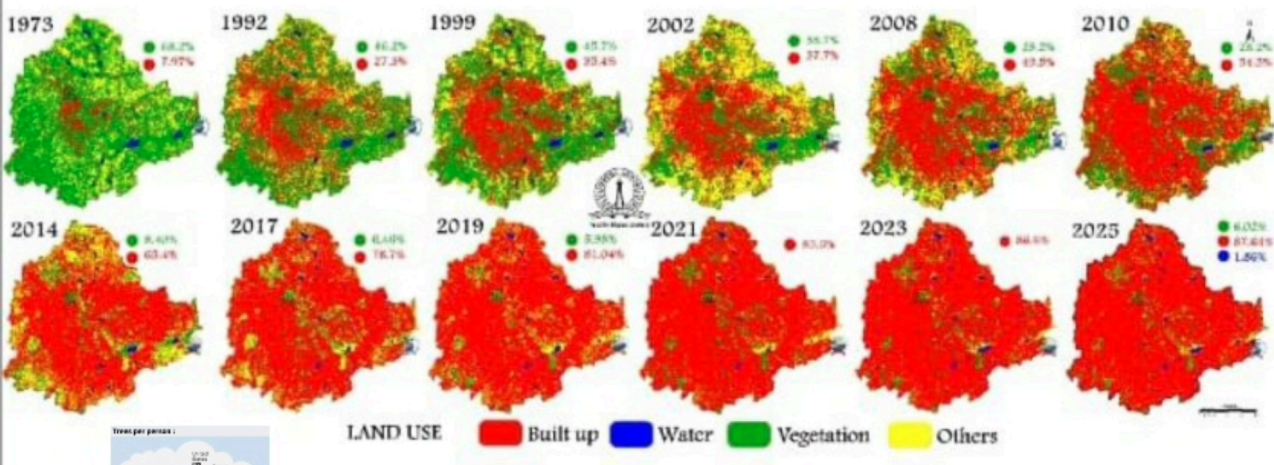

1. STRATEGIC CONTEXT AND PURPOSE

This three-day physical service project was a direct, on-the-ground application of Anveshane's commitment to improving the quality of **public education infrastructure** in rural areas. Collaborating with Gramaantara Trust and the Samparka Team allowed for efficient resource pooling (materials, logistics) while Anveshane provided the essential **volunteer labor**.

The key objectives for this collaboration were:

1. **Enhance Learning Environment:** To physically transform the Government Higher Primary School (GHPS) in Thalahalli, making the campus more appealing and conducive to learning.
2. **Zero-Cost Resource Contribution:** To maximize the impact of the activity by contributing three full days of high-effort volunteer work, adhering to the **Self-Sustaining Model's** principle of leveraging time over funds.
3. **Community Partnership:** To strengthen ties with local community leaders and partner organizations through shared, tangible effort in a rural setting.

2. KEY PROCEEDINGS AND EXECUTION

The project involved an intensive, three-day effort by the Anveshane team members, demonstrating dedication and physical capacity:

- **Direct Service Delivery:** Anveshane members were fully responsible for the preparation, painting, and cleaning of the school buildings.
- **Rural Focus:** Targeting a GHPS in Chikkaballapur ensures that Anveshane's efforts are reaching areas most in need of infrastructure support, fulfilling the mandate for **inclusive development**.
- **Collaborative Efficiency:** The partnership ensured that the necessary materials (paint, brushes, thinners, safety gear) and logistical support (food, water) were efficiently managed, allowing the Anveshane volunteers to focus entirely on the physical execution.
- **Three-Day Immersion:** The duration of the drive allowed for a substantial and visible transformation of the school property, ensuring a lasting positive impact.

3. ORGANIZATIONAL OUTCOMES AND IMPACT

- **Networking and Awareness:** Mahendra's presence facilitates informal networking with activists and community members, enriching Anveshane's understanding of inclusivity issues.

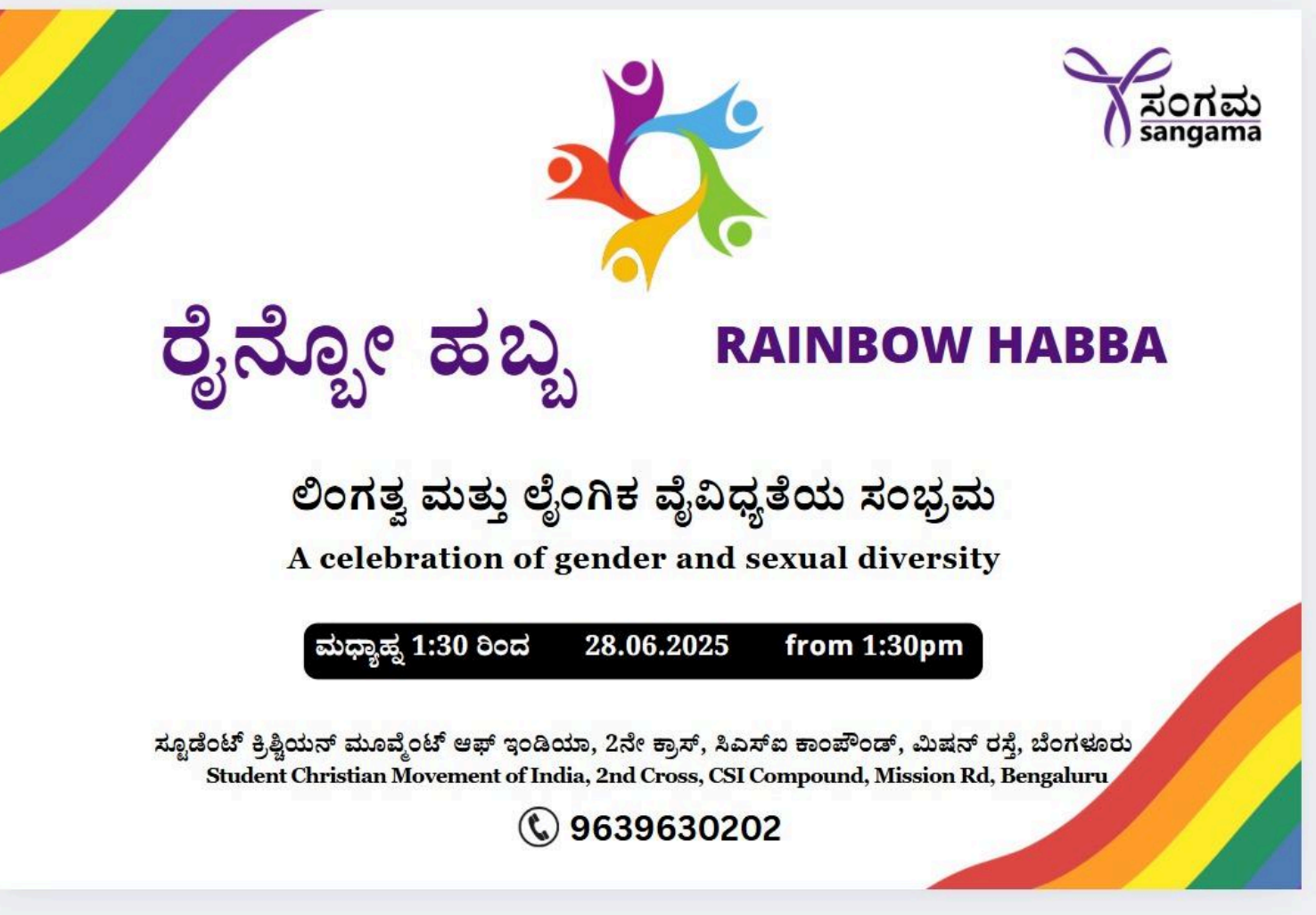

- **Collaborative Action:** Working alongside **PaNaSa** and the joint coalition, Anveshane ensured its efforts amplified the collective voice, demonstrating the strength of the coordinated social justice ecosystem.
